The Syrah grapes used to make the 2023 Rosillo Rosé endow it naturally with a brilliant rose color. This grape was chosen from a plot in the vineyard positioned on a steep slope. This verticality, along with the granite at the soil's surface, is crucial in preserving acidity and giving the wine a firm but delicate structure, one that causes the wine to linger in the mouth for a while after sipping. The Rosillo is a juice-forward wine, with aromatic traces of white flowers, strawberries and raspberries along with a touch of a chili and green pepper. In the mouth it is energetic, crisp, and full of tension, qualities that point to the grapes' granite origin and the freshness of Las Dichas, our spot in the Casablanca Valley. The mineral profile of this wine recommends its pairing with figs, blue or goat cheese, or a seasonal salad with arugula, cherry tomatoes, and nuts.
