



In the early 1900s, Carl John Kingston left his home in Michigan looking for gold in Chile. While he never found his mother lode, his search yielded a cattle ranch in Casablanca Valley, just 12 miles from the Pacific. Five generations later, his descendants are showing the same pioneering spirit. But instead of prospecting for gold, they're exploring new frontiers in Chilean winemaking.

Kingston Family handcrafts Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Syrah, and Sauvignon Blanc from our vineyards in western Casablanca. The names of our wines are inspired by favorite family horses from years past.

We are one of a handful of Chilean vineyards leveraging artisan winemaking and organic viticultural techniques to uncover the potential of coastal Chile. Kingston also collaborates in MOVI, Chile's Movement of Independent Winemakers, whose members make small lots of artisan wines by hand.

Highly regarded winemakers. Amael Orrego and Byron Kosuge lead our Chilean-American winemaking team. In 2016 we began our transition to certified organic vineyards.

Our wines are handcrafted and bottled on our family farm in Chile, and then we import and sell them from our office in California. In 2017 Wine Spectator called us out as "showing a deft hand with Pinot Noir". In addition to wine critics, our wines have been embraced by many sommeliers and have found success in top restaurants, including La Mar Cebichería in San Francisco, Daniel in New York, and Boragó in Santiago.
